How does a Government which was elected to give transparent equality to everyone contemplate this? Why must all students be forced to conform to the same set of narrow rules? Are you not concerned with preparing all students for all future challenges which they will encounter? The Government may wish the homosexual/lesbian community to rule the world but that will not prepare Australia to face the world when the challenges of a falling birth rate start to ravage the economy.
