

In relation to the proposal to legalise discrimination Christian Schools by the Federal Government I wish to draw attention to the following shortfalls in the said proposed amendments.

1. There is no mention of a similar act of discrimination against other major religious schools eg Islamic, Assyrian, Hare Krishna, Coptic Orthodox, Greek Orthodox or Jewish.
2. This discrimination against one of the major world religions opens the door to similar discrimination against all political parties in Australia.
3. Therefore I propose a bill that demands that every political party in Australia MUST by law, allow anyone, regardless of political persuasion to become a member and stand to represent that party without recrimination. No party is permitted to discriminate against people who don't support their beliefs to become members. Expulsion of such members will result in heavy penalties.
