We want to hear from a wide range of voices. Your diverse experiences and points of view will help us to make better recommendations.



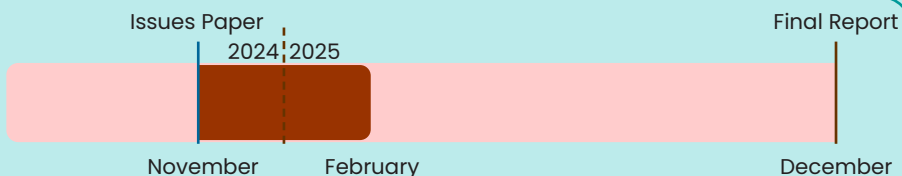

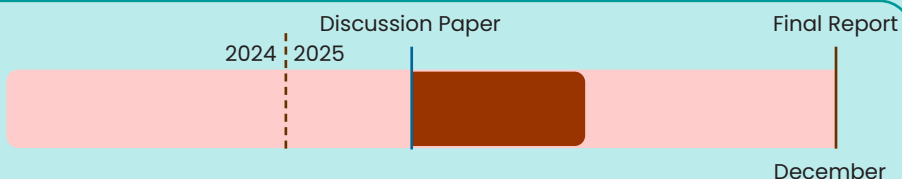
